# 2. <u>Cash Contract No. 490 – Univar Solutions USA, Inc. – Sodium Bisulfite Supply</u>

General Manager reviewed his staff report related to Cash Contract No. 490 with Univar Solutions USA, Inc. for the provision of bulk sodium bisulfite for a two-year term. A competitive joint bidding process for a two-year supply of sodium hypochlorite and sodium bisulfite was undertaken with the Goleta Sanitary District. The lowest responsive and responsible bid was submitted by Univar Solutions USA, Inc.

Director Damron made a motion, seconded by Director Velasco that the Board approve Cash Contract No. 490 between the District and Univar Solutions USA, Inc. for the two-year supply of bulk sodium bisulfite at the unit price of \$1.109 per gallon delivered, including all applicable sales tax and mill charges. A competitive joint bidding process for a two-year supply of sodium hypochlorite and sodium bisulfite was undertaken with the Goleta Sanitary District. The lowest responsive and responsible bid was submitted by HASA, Inc.

Director Velasco made a motion, seconded by Director Graf that the Board approve Cash Contract No. 491 between the District and HASA, Inc. for the two-year supply of bulk sodium hypochlorite at the unit price of \$0.815 per gallon delivered, including all applicable sales tax and mill charges.
